#### **PGNS Website: Did You Know?**

At the bottom of the PGNS website sidebar there is a Subscribe function. Enter your email address and hit the Subscribe button. Then any time there is a new post on the website you will receive an email from WordPress to let you know (check your spam folder). You will not be flooded with emails! At most there are two or three new posts a month. If at any time you wish to unsubscribe just let the webmaster know (webmaster@photoguild.ns.ca) and you will be removed from the subscription list.

When you look up your competition scores from the members only web page you can enter that table into a spreadsheet app. Just select all the rows (drag from top left to bottom right) and copy. Open your spreadsheet app (Mac Numbers, Windows Excel, etc.) and paste into the first field. You now have all your score information in a spreadsheet where you can sort and print.

Walking Tour of Historic Halifax

This was an excellent walking tour by Dr. Lou Collins, packed with information on heraldry symbolism, historic buildings, humor and gossip of the 17 and 1800's. We were fortunate to have Mr. Collins conduct our tour. A.W. (Dooley) Churchill, City of Halifax, Heritage Co-ordinator, speaks of Dr. Collins with very high regards: "There are probably no Haligonians in our time perhaps ever - who have amassed the ultimate knowledge of hometown history, its characters, their doings and the places and structures they knew as Dr. Lou Collins, nor more importantly, who have done as much to see its evidence conserved, restored, appreciated and enjoyed by native and visitor alike".

In the evening Dr. Collins gave an excellent seminar on Historical Halifax highlighting his talk with photos. We were also given a bonus - Mrs. Collins spoke on Louisburg, also with very good slides.
