The ever-evolving incorporation of AI in our favourite post-processing apps can make it hard to keep track of which ones are "safe" to use for competition. As a reminder, images submitted in CAPA competitions must include all their metadata which includes camera settings, editing software used, editing history, date and time information.

CAPA will be adopting the Content Credential model (C2PA standards) to address the challenges posed by the AI-generated synthetic content in photography. These standards apply to images which have been modified using AI enhancement tools.


